**Class 1:** 18 years and over Open Class (BE 100 test 102 (2010) and approx 3ft jumps)

**Class 2:** 17 years and under Open Class (PC Novice Dressage Test (2009) and approx 3ft jumps)

**Class 3:** 18 years and over Novice Class (BE 90 Test 92 (2009) and approx 2ft6 jumps)

**Class 4:** 17 years and under Novice Class (PC Novice Eventing Test (2006) and approx 2ft6 jumps)

**Class 5:** 18 years and over Nursery Novice Class (BD Prelim 14 (2006) and approx 2ft jumps)

**Class 6:** 17 years and under Nursery Novice Class (PC Introductory Dressage Test 2007 and approx 2ft jumps)

Classes 1, 2, 3 & 4 will be qualifiers for the 2010 Knockhill Cross Country Championships (final at Gleneagles on Oct 10<sup>th</sup>).

Rosettes to 6th place. Entry fees: NEFRC members £30 and non-members £35. This includes £3 per rider for FIRST AID cover.

**Entries Close Monday 16<sup>th</sup> August and must be pre-paid.**

#### **Rules of the Course**

1. Your safety is your responsibility. We do not accept liability for any accident, injury, illness, loss or damage to you, your horse, your vehicle or your belongings whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
2. The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
3. All riders must wear a hat to the current approved standard (correctly fastened, no fixed peak) when mounted. Body protectors and medical armbands must be worn when jumping.
4. Please be aware that this is a working farm and there may be machinery or stock moving about. Children should be closely supervised and dogs (on leads) must be under control at all times.
5. By signing the disclaimer below you are agreeing to abide by the rules. An adult must sign for any rider under 16 years old.
6. Anyone riding should ensure that they are covered for third party public liability insurance.
7. No watches allowed.
8. There will be 'L' fences at the more difficult fences on the course. 15 penalties are incurred for jumping an 'L' fence.
9. Entry fees will be refunded only for withdrawals presented in writing before the closing date.
10. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be returned less £5 for administration.
11. Refreshments will be on sale.
12. Class numbers will be restricted.
13. Bibs should be collected from the secretary and will cost £5 (which will be refunded on return of the bib).
14. The organiser's decision is final.
15. Competition will be run under the BRC Rules of Competition.
